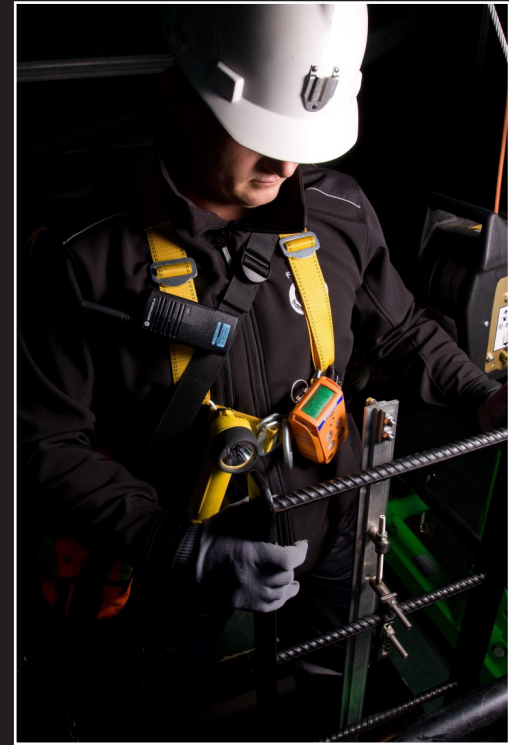

The contract for the 'Renal Day Ward: Floor Strengthening' project at the Royal Free Hospital in London was awarded to Carmelcrest at Competitive Tender.

The Requirement

Recent surveys revealed that the hospital's flooring structure beneath the Renal Day Ward was seriously unstable, the floor was bowing into the 700mm void below and was estimated to collapse at any moment. The scope of works involved going underneath the floor's cavity and erecting a series flooring support systems that were tailored to fit the specific requirements of this project. The system covered an area of approximately 720m².

As can be seen from the above images, there is nothing pretty about this project, rather the key objective on this scheme was to safely and quickly complete the works to meet structural compliance.

Due its risky and challenging nature, all other contractors invited to tender for this scheme were reluctant to take it on. However Carmelcrest do not shy away from risk, despite the nature we still offered a competitive price, completing the works quickly, safely and to the clients satisfaction.

A close liaison combined with a great amount of trust with the on-site client representative was inevitable. Our in-house specialist team of confined space trained operatives, all of whom possessed DBS Clearances were able to safely and successfully complete this project on time and on budget.
