This project was awarded to Carmelcrest at competitive tender. We were required to refurbish and alter various wards and areas at the St Thomas' Hospital in the City of London so that the facilities complied with DDA (Disability Discrimination Act) regulations. Works were as follows:

- Installation of brand new, and alteration of existing DDA compliant wet rooms, ramps, stair lifts, kitchen and bathrooms;
- Specialist easy-hinge IPS (Integrated Plumbing Systems);
- Internal painting and decorating;
- Anti-slip vinyl flooring installed;
- Mechanical and electrical services (plumbing, lighting & air-conditioning);
- Wall partitioning and clinical cladding.

The hospital was occupied and therefore very delicate in nature. We ensured the safety of the patients and staff by segregating working areas with clinical easy-clean hoarding. We appointed a dedicated site manager to oversee the works. All of our workforce contained enhanced DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) clearances.
